## Autism Education Trust Training

Nationally recognised training programmes to share knowledge and good practice for all staff working with pupils in the 5 - 16 age range.

Three programmes are available:

**Making Sense of Autism** – a 90 minute session looking into 'What is Autism'

**Good Autism Practice** – delivered over 2 three hour sessions, this programme looks at individual children and how to understand their specific needs relating to Autism

**Leading Good Autism Practice** - this full day course provides leaders with the skills needed to evaluate Autism practice within their own setting, enhance knowledge and understanding and evaluate and develop practice
